Judicial decrees, decisions, attitudes, and orders issued by Palestinians bodies:

- Saeb Erekat warned against Arab normalization with Israel in exchange for canceling the annexation. (June 29, 2020) .click here
- The Palestinian Authority announced its readiness to resume talks with Israel from where it stopped in 2014 and to slightly modify the borders as an alternative to the century deal. (July 1, 2020).click here
- Saeb Erekat said that the PLO does not accept the scrapping of the Arab Peace Initiative. (July 2, 2020).click here
- Rajoub and Arouri said in a direct press conference broadcast by the official Palestinian TV that Fatah and Hamas will jointly face the annexation. (July 2, 2020).click here

- The Jordanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs **condemned the Israeli plan to build an elevator** connecting the Old City of Jerusalem with the Buraq Wall. (June 29, 2020)., click here
- Senior lawmakers from the British Labor Party have called for a ban on imports of Israeli settlements if the annexation takes place. (June 29, 2020). click here
- Michel Bachelet, the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights, said, "Annexation is illegal.
