This weekly report reviews the legal dynamics of the Palestine question, and everything related to international law and Palestine. The report further covers decisions, decrees, and judicial orders affecting the Palestinian cause, whether made at the official, academic or public levels. The report aims to be a reference for monitoring, documenting and archiving the latest human rights developments related to Palestine, and to present them to individuals, researchers, study centers, and official, academic and legal institutions concerned.

Judicial decrees, decisions, positions, and orders issued by Israeli official bodies:

- The HCJ received a petition demanding that the Israeli army **be required to obtain a judicial warrant before entering and searching Palestinians' residences** (March 22, 2020). click here
- The HCJ received a joint letter from several institutions demanding **that Palestinian prisoners be allowed to communicate with their families** whether by a phone call or visit after canceling visits following the Corona pandemic. (March 26, 2020). click here
- the Israeli Supreme Court received an urgent petition against emergency regulations enacted in the shadow of the coronavirus crisis preventing lawyers and family members from meeting with prisoners being held in Israeli detention (March 26, 2020).
