- The Palestinian Cabinet issued a decision to prevent Israeli goods and products, including vegetables, fruits, mineral water, and soda, from entering the Palestinian territories on the basis of reciprocity. (February 3, 2020). click here
- The Palestinian Cabinet issued a decision to form a national team to work on recovering the bodies of Palestinian and Arab martyrs held by the Israeli occupation. (February 3, 2020). click here
