Judicial decrees, decisions, attitudes, and orders issued by Arab, European and international bodies:

- The Security Council issued a decision to **remove the condemnation of the deal of the century** and retreated from holding the international conference on the deal of the century after a Palestinian draft resolution to condemn the deal was issued. (February 9, 2020). click [here](#)
