

Papers and Articles Submission

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

L4P is glad to announce that we are now receiving papers and articles concerning the Situation of Palestine in International Criminal Court.

We welcome submissions from law scholars, early career scholars and academicians from all parts of the world. Co-authored papers are acceptable, but all authors must meet the eligibility criteria below. The papers and articles that meet the publication criteria of L4P will be published on our website in both Arabic and English, and their authors will be awarded a member status in the [Jurists for Palestine Forum](#) for 3 months. Moreover, L4P will promote those writings on its social media platforms.

Eligibility criteria:

- Authors should have a law degree or a background in the field of international law.
- Papers must be primarily based on the concept note made by L4P on this month topic (each month has its own concept note (theme) – for this month theme, check our [website](#)).

Writing criteria:

- Submitted papers should not be under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- The writings should be original and reflect the author's own thoughts.
- Any reference to a primary or a secondary source should be cited properly.
- The research papers should not exceed **2500** words, including the footnotes.
- Our referencing style is through hyperlinks, and if the source is unavailable online or requires further explanation, endnotes according to Chicago style are to be used.
- Authors need to clearly answer the article/paper's questions with proper legal reasoning and analysis.
- Authors should be closely in touch with L4P during the process of editing the writings to meet the criteria. The process may have several steps where the author might have to edit it more than once.
- Once approved for publication, the copyrights of the article/paper are automatically transferred to L4P. The author would not attempt to publish elsewhere without notifying L4P and attaining its written permission.
- Once finally approved, the article/paper would be published within a maximum of three weeks. Authors will be provided with the online link of the publication.
- L4P will be committed to promoting the writings and refer to their authors' names on its social media pages.
- Writings in both English or Arabic would be accepted. L4P will translate papers and publish them in both languages.

Papers that fail to meet the eligibility terms and writing criteria may not be published. Sending the article does not necessarily mean that L4P is obliged to publish it. Authors will be notified once the writing has been approved.
