- Israel is relaunching the E1 settlement plan, which aims to dismantle the geographical contiguity between the Palestinian neighborhoods of East Jerusalem and the Palestinian cities of Ramallah and Bethlehem. (May 31, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
- The Israeli Knesset preliminarily ratifies a bill prohibiting raising f the Palestinian flag atsState-funded institutions with a majority of 63 votes in favor and 16 against. (June 1, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
- The Israeli government admits before the Israeli Supreme Court that the "Homesh" outpost in the northern West Bank is illegal. The court orders the government to provide an update

- Jordan, Kuwait, Egypt, Qatar, UAE, Bahrain, and Oman condemn the extremist Israeli settlers' storming of the Al-Aqsa Mosque under Israeli police protection. (May 29, 2022). For further details, click here
- <u>The Gulf Cooperation Council</u>, <u>the OIC</u>, <u>Arab Parliament</u>, and the <u>Arab League</u> condemn allowing the Israeli extremists and a member of the Israeli Knesset to storm the Al-Aqsa Mosque. (May 29, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
- The Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson states that the intensification of the Palestinian-Israeli conflict goes back to the fact that the two-state solution has never been implemented.

It considers how the session of Mohammad, an employee in an international humanitarian organization, targets the work of human rights and humanitarian organizations covering up the Israeli practices and crimes and thus violates the simplest rules of the international law.
