- <u>Qatar</u>, <u>Kuwait</u>, <u>Egypt</u>, <u>Jordan</u> and <u>Turkey</u> condemned the storming of Al-Aqsa Mosque by the occupation army and settlers. (September 26, 2022).
- <u>The Arab League (LAS)</u>, <u>the Arab Parliament</u> and <u>the Organization of Islamic Cooperation</u> (OIC) condemned the storming of Al-Aqsa Mosque by the Israeli occupation and settlers. (September 26, 2022).

- The United Nations Special Coordinator for the Middle East Peace Process (UNSCO) affirms that the absence of a peace process aimed at ending the Israeli occupation is causing dangerous deterioration throughout the occupied Palestinian territory. - The European Union regrets the "loss of human lives" and expresses worry over the
 escalation of violence in Jenin following the intervention of Israeli occupation troops, which

- The United Nations Special Coordinator for the Middle East Peace Process (UNSCO) for the Security Council stated that since the adoption of Resolution 2334 in December 2016, which demands Israel stop building new settlements on Palestinian land, there has been "little progress" in its implementation.
