This weekly report reviews the legal dynamics of the Palestine question, and everything related to international law and Palestine. The report includes an account of the most important publications, activities, and conferences related to Palestine at the local, regional, international levels. The report further covers decisions, decrees, and judicial orders affecting the Palestinian cause, whether made at the official, academic or public levels. The report aims to be a reference for monitoring, documenting, and archiving the latest human rights developments related to Palestine, and to present them to individuals, researchers, study centers, and official, academic, and legal institutions concerned.

Judicial decrees, decisions, positions, and orders issued by official Palestinian bodies:

- The Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs decried the occupation authorities' seizure of 360 dunums of Palestinian citizens' land in Salfit's Dahr Sobh neighborhood, as well as the continued violence in Hebron. (November 27, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
- The Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs condemned the incursions of settlers and extremist Jews into Al-Aqsa mosque, saying they were illegal and part of the occupying power's attempts to divide the mosque and construct another structure in its place. - The Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs criticised the Hebrew media for its coverage of the Israeli government's expansionist settlement plans to commence building 9,000 dwellings and commercial units on the Kalandia airport's site in occupied Jerusalem. - The Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs condemned the field execution of brothers Jawad and Thafer Rimawi (22 and 21 years old) from Beit Rima, who were shot by Israeli occupying forces in Kafr Ayn, north-west of Ramallah, as well as the execution of young man Mufeed Mohammad Mahmoud Ekhlil (44) from Beit Omar in Hebron. - President Mahmoud Abbas called on the European Union and its member states not to deal with any Israeli government that does not recognize the two-state solution on the basis of international legitimacy and signed agreements and does not renounce violence and terrorism. - The Palestinian Foreign Ministry condemns the ongoing violations the Israeli forces and colonial militia are committing against the Palestinian people in the West Bank and East Jerusalem, at the instigation of Ben Gvir and Smotrich. Also, the PFM condemns the unjust siege and abuses against Palestinians in the Gaza Strip that amount to war crimes and crimes against humanity (December 1, 2022). - The US State Department has warned of the Netanyahu-Smotrich deal that completes the creeping annexation of the West Bank, stressing the real dangers it poses. (December 2, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
- The Palestinian Presidency confirmed that the Israeli occupation's cold-blooded execution of young man Ammar Mufleh in the town of Hawara, south of Nablus, is a horrific act in a long line of crimes against the Palestinian people. (December 2, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
- The Palestinian Prime Minister urged the UN to present to the Security Council a Middle East peace initiative and to employ the presence of UN institutions in border areas to hinder

- An agreement between Likud and Otzma Yehudit on the roles of the far-right party in the new government would see Itamar Ben Gvir in the newly established office of National Security Minister, which includes control of the national police and border police in the West Bank. - Prime Minister-designate Benjamin Netanyahu granted far-right leader Bezalel Smotrich extensive powers over Israeli settlements and Palestinian construction in the West Bank as part of a coalition agreement signed between the two parties. Judicial decrees, decisions, positions, and orders issued by Arab, European, and international bodies:

- Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) has denounced Israel's ongoing atrocities in Palestinian land, as well as the murders of brothers Jawad and Thafer Rimawi and Mufid Ekhlil. (November 29, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
- In a letter to the chairman of the Committee on the Inalienable Rights of the Palestinian
 People on the International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People, the King of Jordan
 emphasized that the Palestinian struggle has been and will continue to be the major

concern in the area. He believes that the right to self-determination belongs to every person, is protected by the United Nations, and cannot be denied to Palestinians. (November 29, 2022). For further details, click <u>here</u>
